Today for the first 4 hours was the meeting of the Tournament Rules and Ratings Commission.

There were changes to review in the rules which are tedious to discuss here and some like Tie Break Systems were tabled until the proposals could be more clearly written.

The roles of the Chief Arbiter and Chief Organizer of events were spelled out a bit more in terms of responsibility. The process for selection of Appeals Committees were also spelled out more.

The 'count-down timer' issue that was brought forward before was clarified. This is not for all FIDE rated events but instead for FIDE major events such as World, Continental, and Sub-continental championships.

Once again the ACP via Maiceja sent a packet of questions (it was 15 pages thick) asking questions to educate him. Some were valid and some were off the wall. I moved in the beginning that while the RTR committee must respond to all inquiries, it doesn't have to do so when a limited time session such as a Congress meeting is happening and especially when the asker is not present, nor when it was sent the day before the meeting and the commission members haven't had a chance to review them. We ran out of time anyways to discuss the matters.

Timing did not allow me to get to the Commission on Women's chess in the afternoon unfortunately.
